ADOPT-A-COT

The Adopt-a-cot fundraiser has been very successful since we started a few years ago.

For those of you who don't know how it works, people adopt a cot for 6,000 kshs per year (\$120 AUD, \$120 US, \$120 CAN, 60 GBP, 85 Euros).

A photo and details of the baby in that cot are sent out with 3 monthly updates on the progress of the baby. When he or she leaves to join the adopted family, details of the next baby in the cot are sent out. Reminders are sent after 12 months to ask if the person wants to continue.
